

**South Central States Mission Center
Conference Minutes
September 19, 2009**

The meeting was called to order by President Charles Davenport at 9:12 AM. The first order of business was the approval of the minutes for the Mission Center Conference of October 25, 2008 and the Special Conference of May 23, 2009. After the reading of the May minutes, President Davenport asked if there were any additions or corrections. There being none, he declared the minutes approved.

2010 Budget

Apostle Maupin then took the chair and asked for a motion to consider the budget. The motion to consider was made by Charles Davenport and seconded. After explanation and some discussion the body approved the budget.

World Conference Delegate Election

Charles Davenport then took the chair for World Church delegate election. Ballots were distributed for election of World Church delegates. After a number of names were added to the ballot Linda Ricke moved that since the delegation count is 67 that all 60 names be declared delegates. The motion was seconded and carried. Note: Beverly Seeman of Jonesboro, AR was mistakenly left off of the printed slate of delegates and was subsequently added by authority of the mission center president bringing the total number of delegates for the South Central States Mission Center to 61.

Sustaining Mission Center Leaders

Apostle Maupin took the chair and read a letter from the First Presidency recommending that Charles Davenport be approved as Mission Center President and Mission Center Financial Officer for 2010. The conference sustained Charles Davenport as President and Financial Officer.
